Sequoia & Kings Canyon Road Conditions (559) 565-3341 www.recreation.gov	Portions are open, check park website www.nps.gov/seki Open Areas of Sequoia National Park The foothills area of Sequoia National Park is open for 6 miles along the Generals Highway to Hospital Rock Picnic Area. There is no access to sequoia groves via the Hwy 198 entrance. Visitor center and park book store open. Limited services. Open Areas of Kings Canyon National Park The Grant Grove area is open and offers opportunities to see a sequoia grove. Snacks and supplies are available at the market. This is the only open area with sequoias. Enter along Highway 180. HWY 180 is R1, please bring chains. HWY 198 is open from Ash Mountain Entrance to Hospital Rock. The road between the parks is closed.
CA Highway Conditions Outside the National Parks (800) 427-7623 www.roads.dot.ca.gov	Road work will begin in May on Highway 49 from the Mariposa/Madera County line to the Route 49/Route 140 south junction in Mariposa and go through the winter of 2022.
Wawona Road – Delays	The Wawona Campground Sewer Contractor will be installing pull boxes at nine locations on Wawona Road between the Wawona Campground and Chilnualna Falls Road, and on Chilnualna Falls Road between Wawona Road and the UC Merced buildings. Expect a one-lane closure with traffic control for approximately a 100 ft. section, and up to 10-minute delays Monday through Friday, 7AM-5PM, until January 21 st .
Big Oak Flat Road – Blasting	Trail Crew is planning to blast a boulder on Big Oak Flat Road Tuesday, January 11. There will be intermittent traffic delays that morning.
Tioga Road Delays – Closed for the season.	This is a 2-year rehabilitation project. Crews will shut down for the winter when the road closes. They will start up again in the spring of 2022 and continue throughout summer. This project is scheduled to be completed by the end of fall 2022.

Hiking Information	Bridalveil Fall Closed due to rehabilitation work on trails and parking. The 4 Mile trail is currently closed. The Mist Trail from its junction with the John Muir Trail above Vernal Fall footbridge to the top of Vernal Fall is closed due to icy conditions. The John Muir Trail between Clark Point and Panorama Trail junction (near the top of Nevada Fall) is closed due to icy conditions. The normal winter route is in effect.
Tuolumne Meadows	Closed for the season. Tuolumne Lodge & White Wolf Lodge both plan to reopen on June 3 rd , 2022.
Overnight Climbing Permits	All visitors planning to overnight on any rock-climbing routes in Yosemite National Park will be required to obtain an overnight wilderness climbing permit beginning on May 21, 2021. This pilot program is being implemented to better understand how park visitors use Yosemite's big walls and to help improve climbing wilderness ethics and reduce negative human impacts associated with overnight big wall use. https://www.nps.gov/yose/planyourvisit/climbing.htm .
Seasonal Climbing Closures	All climbing restrictions have been lifted.
Winter Use Cabins	Tuolumne Ski Hut, Snow Creek Cabin and Ostrander Ski Hut will remain closed to the public for the winter of 2021/22, as they were in 2020/21.

NPS Snowshoe Walks	Ranger-led snowshoe walks will be on Saturdays, Sundays, and Wednesdays beginning December 18. New this year, reservations are required by 2pm the day before the snowshoe walk. Walks are limited to 30 people. Reservations must be made by calling (209) 379-1899.
Pile Burning	Pile burning beginning January 19 th 2022: Fire crews are planning to conduct pile burning operations beginning the 19 th of January, as conditions allow. Locations include the Hetch Hetchy Entrance Station, Crane Flat, Merced Grove, and areas around Mariposa Grove; burning will likely continue over the next few weeks. Smoke may be present throughout burning operations and may linger into the following weeks as large logs are consumed.
Construction & Pedestrian Detours	Yosemite Valley Welcome Center Construction Beginning, with Pedestrian Detours: Construction on the Yosemite Valley Welcome Center will begin in late January 2022. The contractor will stage their operations in the south end of the Village Store parking lot. The adjacent South & North Parking Lot project will also stage in this area. Pedestrians moving between day-use parking and Yosemite Village will be detoured around the project site. The Village Grill will operate this spring & summer. Construction will continue through spring 2023.
