#### **YOSEMITE DELAYS, PROJECTS & CONSTRUCTION:**

Glacier Point Road Project: 2022-2023  NPS.gov/Yose/PlanYourVisit/ gproadfaq.htm	Glacier Point Road will be <b>CLOSED</b> to all traffic in 2022 to rehabilitate and improve the road. The only access to Glacier Point will be via the Four Mile, Panorama, and Pohono Trails, all of which are strenuous hikes. There will be 30-minute delays in 2023. Construction will take place from spring through fall of 2022 and 2023, unless unforeseen weather extends the project. <b>NOTE:</b> The road to Badger Pass and Glacier Point is <b>CLOSED</b> to bicycle, pedestrian, and public vehicle traffic.
Tioga Road / Hwy 120 Delays & Tuolumne Meadows	This is a 2-year rehabilitation project. Crews will shut down for the winter when the road closes. They will start up again in the spring of 2022 and continue throughout summer. This project is scheduled to be completed by the end of fall 2022.
Construction & Pedestrian Detours	Yosemite Valley Welcome Center Construction Beginning, with Pedestrian Detours: Construction on the Yosemite Valley Welcome Center will begin in late January 2022. The contractor will stage their operations in the south end of the Village Store parking lot. The adjacent South & North Parking Lot project will also stage in this area. Pedestrians moving between day-use parking and Yosemite Village will be detoured around the project site. Construction will continue through spring 2023. 7/6/2022: Approximately half of the South Lot Parking in Yosemite Village is closed for construction. Crews will be operating heavy equipment between the South Lot & North Lot throughout the summer.
