Rockfall - Closure of the John Muir Trail	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On April 15, a large rockfall occurred from the slope above the John Muir Trail between Clark Point and the top of Nevada Fall. • The trail will remain closed for at least several more weeks.
Merced River Closure; Clark's Bridge to El Capitan Bridge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Effective Monday April 22, the Merced River between Clark's Bridge to El Capitan Bridge will be closed to boating (non-motorized vessels) due to flows above 7.0 feet at the Pohono Bridge River gauge.
Arch Rock Bypass Project Delayed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This summer we will be piloting the Arch Rock Bypass on the El Portal Road (Hwy 140).
Caltrans Announces Improvement Project on State Route 140: Cathey's Valley to Mariposa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caltrans has begun a maintenance project to improve State Route 140 (SR-140) between Cathey's Valley and the town of Mariposa until December 2024.
